

Cheadle Mosque (CMA) Waqf Project – Ramadhan - 2011

Your Mosque MashAllah continues to grow – we are witness to the ever increasing numbers at the congregational Salah & at Salatul Jum’ah and the expanding number of activities, circles & talks. In order to maintain this growth and development however we do require continuous funding and income; in our continued aim to become more self-sufficient we have committed to a further Waqf property. MashAllah our two current Waqf properties are let to Muslim families and are generating a constant rental income stream for the Mosque, purchasing this further property will consolidate this and support the Mosque in its growth and service to the community.

Waqf is a special kind of charity. It refers to an original gift that is used to bring a continuous return hence it becomes a form of continuous charity (**Sadaqah Jariyah**), and the rewards for this type of charity continue even after the donor's death - for as long as people continue to benefit from the Waqf.

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) used to establish Waqf himself, and he regarded Waqf as one of the best forms of charity.

“If a human dies, then his good deeds stop except for three: a Sadaqah Jariyah (continuous charity), a beneficial knowledge, or a righteous child who prays for him”. Muslim.

When we give in charity, we realise it sometimes can be difficult, but we should take heed from the Qur’an and the promise Allah(Swt) bequeaths to the charitable one:

“You will never attain righteousness until you spend (in the way of Allah) from that which you love; and whatever you spend - indeed, Allah is knowing of it.” Al-Imran 3 : 92.

“Say, “Indeed, my Lord extends provision for whom He wills of His servants and restricts (it) for him. But whatever thing you spend (in His cause) – He will compensate it: and He is the best of providers.” Saba’ 34 : 39

Finally let us remember that when we give in charity – we give for the benefit of our own souls, it can be argued that in fact we as individuals are in greater need of giving charity than the recipient – for it is Allah’s reward that we need and crave.

Giving in charity is one way that we can attain Allah’s reward, sacrificing the wealth that is so loved by us for the sake of Allah(swt) so that we can build our abode in Jannah.
